DELIVERY CONDITIONS

Time-Slot: 08-10 a.m. / 10 a.m. - 12 noon / 12 noon. - 2 p.m. / 2 p.m. - 4 p.m. and are assigned by us. We can allocate 1 truck per time slot.

Please adhere to the time assigned to you, otherwise you will have to wait longer.

RECEIPT OF GOODS

- monday to friday from 8.00am to 4.00pm
- The delivery always has to be announced 5 days before settlement at avis@kalog.com or by phone - Tel. +49(2102)8922-255 Mrs. Schwarz / +49(2102)8922-272 Mrs. Loth
- ATTENTION: The truck can only be unloaded from the rear. Delivery of goods on pallets will only be accepted on Euro pallets
- Maximum weight brut per package - 6 tons
- Maximum drum size - diameter of flange max. 250 cm / width 200 cm
- Euro pallet - maximum 110 cm high (no overlying)
- Pallet weight max. 1000kg
- Quality of pallets: at least quality class B
- Pallets which are in a worse condition and therefore do not meet the above-mentioned classification will not be exchanged by us
- DRY pallets/ drums = no water on the surfaces
- per pallet only one type of cable with the same appearance (same quantity of wires and cross section)
- Those products which are not sufficient for the filling of a complete range, have to be packed on mixed pallets. Please make sure that different types of cable are separated with cardboards!
- Standard length = 1000m = tolerance +/-0%
- Huge length = 1001m = tolerance +/-5%
- Characteristics of the drums: Please do not deliver moldy drums. Only use dry drums to prevent mold growth.

PACKAGING OF PALLETS

The pre-packed pallets shall be wrapped with stretch film with the following requirements: The pallet frame shall be wrapped to prevent the goods from slipping during storage and transport. The pallet film must not stick or weld to the goods.

LOADING OF DRUMS

Drums loaded loose and/or on pallets must be secured on the truck according to VDI 2700. Drums standing on the flange on pallets are to be firmly connected to the pallet with at least 2 straps that go through the drum core. In addition, square timbers must be firmly attached to the pallet to secure the drum against slipping. VDI 2700 also applies here. Drums from a size of 1.40 may only be delivered upright. As long as this is permitted, they must be delivered on a pallet.
